

THE NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND POSTS COMMISSION (EETT)

Having regard to:

- a. Law . 2867/2000 on the Organization and Operation of Telecommunications and other Provisions (Government Gazette Issue No. 273/A/2000) and more specifically Article 3 (14) (a) and (aa),
- b. EETT Decision 268/73/25.11.2002 on a .gr. Domain Name Management and Assignment Regulation (Government Gazette Issue No. 1617/B/2002), and its Article 16 in particular,
- c. the Services Contract between EETT and FORTH dated July, 31, 2003, as has been amended and is in force,
- d. the results of the Public Consultation carried out by EETT during the period from 2.12.2003 to 9.1.2004 on the submission of viewpoints regarding the .GR Register project,
- e. the fact that the provisions of this Decision do not lead to any expenditures to be charged to the State Budget, has adopted this Decision:

It issues a Regulation on the Determination of the Fees for Actions on .gr Domain Names, the contents of which are as follows:

Article 1

Scope and Aim

1. The purpose of this Decision is:

(a) to establish the ceiling of the fees paid by the Assigned party to the Assignor for the assignment, renewal and transfer of .gr domain names.

(a) to establish the fees paid by the Assignor to EETT for the assignment, renewal and transfer of .gr domain names.

Article 2

Domain name assignment and use fees

1. For each .gr Domain Name assignment, renewal or transfer, the Assignor shall pay to EETT eleven euro and eighty cents (€ 11.80). No fees shall be paid in case of assignment, renewal, or transfer applications that have been rejected.

2. Assignors shall be held exclusively liable for paying to EETT the fees for the assignment, renewal or transfer of .gr Domain Names of the Assigned parties they serve, otherwise they shall be excluded from the EETT approved Assignors List.

3. If the fees for the assignment, renewal, or transfer of a .gr Domain Name are not paid, EETT shall revoke the act.

4. The ceiling of the fees that the Assigned party may pay to the Assignor is established as follows:

(a) Forty four (44) euro + VAT for the assignment of a .gr Domain Name

(b) Forty four (44) euro + VAT for the transfer of a .gr Domain Name

(c) Twenty nine euros and thirty cents (29.30) + VAT for the renewal of .gr Domain Name

The above fees include the fee the Assignor pays to EETT.

The Assignor may request payment of the above fees even where there is no requirement for the payment of fees to EETT.

5. The fees the Assignor requires of the Assigned party, as well as the General Transaction Conditions governing the actions taken on .gr domain names must be available at the Assignor's website.

6. The fees shall be listed in a visible and easily accessible part of the Assignor's website, in order to enable the competent departments of EETT to check the prices at will.

7. The imposition by an Assignor to an Assigned party of fees exceeding those set out in paragraph 4 of this article is prohibited, otherwise the relevant Assignor shall be excluded from the EETT approved Assignors List.

This Decision shall enter into force from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
