

Announcement of new prices

During its plenary of 21 May 2002, the Hellenic Telecommunications & Post Commission (EETT), with its decision under Protocol No. 253/87¹, set Tariffs for Unbundled Access to the Local Loop of the Hellenic Telecommunications Organisation.

Given the fact that the implementation of both Full and Shared Unbundled Local Loop Access, pursuant to the directives of Regulation (EC) No. 2887/2000 of the European Parliament, requires transparency of prices of individual services/elements of Unbundled Local Loop Access, the current intervention was deemed necessary so that competition within the local access market may function efficiently and so that the competitive provision of electronic communications services may be reinforced.

Tariffs for Full Unbundled and Shared Access were set as follows:

In any occasion, the Beneficiary may dispute the cost orientation of the above prices appealing to the EETT and OTE is responsible for proving the cost orientation.

It should be noted that in order to ensure the principles of cost orientation and transparency during the provision of Unbundled Local Loop Access, the said Decision obligates OTE to provide to every interested Beneficiary a detailed budget of all collocation works that are conducted at its centres. Concurrently, before any of the aforementioned works begin the Beneficiary must previously provide a written consent regarding both the necessity of the works that are recommended by OTE and the amount of the relative prices.
