



New Call Termination Tariffs for Mobile Telephony

In implementing the recent Decisions by EETT (Dec. 392/17/22-06-2006 and Dec. 410/37/15-11-2006) the mobile operators telephony companies COSMOTE, VODAFONE

Based on the information presented in the following tables, the average reduction of the call termination tariff, considering the relevant shares of the market, from January 2006 to June 2007 shall amount to approximately 30%. Moreover, considering the reduction of the withheld fee as of 1-12-2006 for calls made from fixed OTE numbers to mobile numbers, the removal of the minimum charging time as of 1-1-2007 (30 seconds) in call termination tariffs, the average reduction of the retail charge for calls made from fixed to mobile numbers for the period between 1-1-2006 and 1-1-2007, is estimated to be around 27%.

and TIM/ Q-TELECOM have proceeded with new reductions in mobile termination rates which are in effect as of 1-1-2007. According to the aforementioned EETT Decisions, based on the Draft Measures for market 16 as approved by the European Commission (voice call termination on individual mobile networks), mobile telephony companies are obliged to make further reductions in mobile termination rates, so that in June 2007 the relevant rates will be cost-oriented (target price). The following table presents the termination tariffs

minimum charge of 30 seconds.

The mobile termination rate is the wholesale charge that one telecommunications company pays to another company for every call, in order for all calls made by the subscribers of the first company to terminate at the network of the second company. The retail price, that the subscriber is paying, is the sum of the mobile termination rate and an additional fee that is set by the telecommunications company from which the call originates.

The reduction of the call termination tariffs on mobile telephony networks is immediately followed by a significant reduction of retail call rates to mobile numbers from fixed and mobile numbers of a different network. In the framework of its regulatory competencies, and in close co-operation with the European Commission, EETT aims at ensuring the greatest possible benefit for the consumer along with the development of entrepreneurship and investments by electronic communications companies.
