



Public Consultation on the Reference Offer on Full and Shared Access to Metallic Loops and Sub-loops and Relevant Facilities

According to the relevant EETT Decision (Dec. 388/012/30-5-2006), OTE has Significant Market Power in the market for wholesale Unbundled Access (including shared access) to Metallic Loops and Sub-loops and therefore, is subject to Regulatory obligations. One of OTE's most important obligations in the particular market is the publication of a relevant Reference Offer, which will ensure that alternative operators have access to local loops and sub-loops according to equal and clearly defined terms and conditions.

OTE's proposal as to the Reference Offer on Full and Shared Unbundled Access to the Local Loops and Sub-loops and to relevant facilities was submitted in September 2006. EETT has conducted a Public Consultation, providing the interested parties

with the opportunity to submit their comments and remarks on OTE's proposal from 28-09-2006 to 23-10-2006.
