

# Public Consultation regarding the Licensing Procedure for Station Installations, Supporting Equipment and Antennas in Antenna Sites

Within the frame of implementation of article 11, par. 18 of Law 3592/2007, EETT carried out a Public Consultation with regards to the licensing procedure Regulation for the installation of radio communication stations, antenna systems and Supporting Equipment in Antenna Sites. The Regulation under consideration specifies the following:

## Antenna Site

i. The licensing procedure for the installation of radio communication stations, antenna systems and Supporting Equipment in specific locations – points in Antenna Sites, including the evaluation of electromagnetic surcharge in relation to the both the general population as well as the employees of the antenna site.



ii. The specifications for the construction of analogue television and free reception radio and land digital broadcasting antennas, in order to achieve optimum operation.



The provisions of the Regulation under consideration will apply for the installation of antenna systems, transmitters and Supporting Equipment in specific locations in Antenna Sites belong to:

- a) Providers of land-based analogue broadcasting signal transmission networks (pursuant to the contents of articles 6, par. 3 and 8 par. 3, Law 3592/2007).
- b) Providers of land-based digital broadcasting signal transmission networks (pursuant to the contents of article 13, Law 3592/2007).
- c) Providers of radio television broadcasting signal distribution services.
- d) Providers of Electronic Communication services (without prejudice to the provisions of article 4, par. 4, Law 3431/2006) who have the right of installation or accommodation in the sites pursuant to the standing provision.

The implementation of the provisions comprised in the Regulation under consideration with regards to the operation, maintenance, safeguarding and management of Antenna Sites is assigned to the Administrator of each Antenna Site, who is appointed for this purpose to the network providers.

Thus, administration and providers are collaborating towards the previous

direction.
