For the second year in a row, EETT participated in the Thessaloniki International Fair, which took place from the 5th until the 13th of September 2009.

EETT's presence was focused on informing the public on Electronic Communications and Postal Services issues.

More specifically, visitors had the opportunity to:

1. Be informed on broadband Internet and its many applications, through the campaign "Broadband: Find out what it offers" which was launched by EETT.
2. Watch a Geographic Information System-GIS demo featuring the areas of broadband coverage in Greece. By using GIS, consumers can be informed on the broadband speeds provided, as well as tracing Wi-Fi Hot Spots (see p.11).

3. Try the new application for broadband quality measurements in Greece, known as the Broadband Quality Measurements Node-BQMN (see p.13).

4. Be informed of their rights and obligations as users of Electronic Communications and Postal Services, as well as to get useful brochures (i.e. The Informed Consumer's Guide, The Code of Ethics of Electronic Communications Services).

5. Browse the renewed EETT website on broadband, www.broadband.gr.

Also, school children visiting EETT's kiosk received the Illustrated Informatics and Broadband Dictionary which is a useful tool for the better understanding of new technologies.

Finally, the "Consumer's Ombudsman" was also hosted at EETT's kiosk, at a specially designed area. Visitors had the opportunity to get the Ombudsman's brochures with guidance on issues they should be careful about regarding transactions with suppliers of various commercial sectors.
