

# ITU

The [International Telecommunication Union-ITU](#) is the United Nations specialized agency for information and communication technologies – ICTs. It has three main sectors of activity, the Radiocommunication Sector (ITU-R), the Telecommunication Standardization Sector ITU-T and the Telecommunication Development Sector ITU-D. In order to facilitate international connectivity in communications networks, the ITU allocates global radio spectrum and satellite orbits and develops the technical standards that ensure networks and technologies seamlessly interconnect.
