DECISION

Regulation on the Procedure and Conditions for General Authorizations

The National Telecommunications and Post Commission (EETT)

Having regard to:

- 1. Article 5, paragraph 6 of the Law 2867/2000 "Organization and Operation of Telecommunications and other Provisions" (Official Gazette 273/A/2000),
- 2. The fact that the provisions of this Decision do not charge the State Budget with further expenditure,

Decides

The issue of the Regulation for General Authorizations with provisions as below:

Article 1

Object and Definitions

1. The present Regulation regulates the procedure and the conditions for the installation, operation, management and exploitation of telecommunications networks and for the provision of telecommunication Services under the General Authorizations Regime, pursuant to Article 5 of Law 2867/2000.



2. Words or sentences, which are used in the present Regulation, have the meaning of Law 2867/2000 or, in the relevant secondary European Union Law and in the International Regulation of Radio Communications, as it is in force every time.

Article 2

General Authorizations

- 1. General Authorizations are required to provide any Telecommunications activity, unless no License is required in accordance with Article 5, paragraph 2, of Law 2867/2000, or the issue of an Individual License is required, pursuant to Article 6, of Law 2867/2000.
- 2. Under Article 5, paragraph 2 of Law 2867/2000 no Authorization or license is required for the importation, trade, manufacture, installation and maintenance of telecommunications terminal equipment, the installation or/and operation of radio communications stations of foreign embassies and diplomatic assignments or/and radio communication stations installed under bilateral intergovernmental agreements as well as for the simple resale of Telecommunications Services.
- 3. The provider of Simple Resale of Telecommunication Services shall solely notify EETT of its activities on an informal Basis.

Article 3

Procedure

- 1. An application for a General Authorization is required for the commencement of the provision of telecommunication activities, pursuant to this Regulation and Law 2867/2000.
- 2. The application for a General Authorization shall be filed with EETT via a Registration Declaration. In the Registration Declaration, the applicant declares its intent to commence one or more telecommunications activities, describes them, as is required in Annex A to this Regulation, and applies for registration in the Telecommunications



Service Registry. The Registration Declaration shall be accompanied by the information, provided in Annex A to this regulation, where a sample of the Registration Declaration is also included.

- 3. The applicant may initiate the offer of the specified Telecommunications Services as described in the Registration Declaration following the lapse of fifteen (15) days from the complete filing of the Registration Declaration with EETT.
- 4. The fifteen (15) day period shall begin from the day following the receipt of the Registration Declaration or, in case it is incomplete, from the day following the receipt of the complete application.
- 5. If EETT determines there is a need for further information about the intended Telecommunication Service, the applicant can be asked to wait up to four (4) weeks from the filing of the application prior to the commencing the provision of the Telecommunications Services, by means of a justified decision, which is issued within the fifteen (15) day period referred above in paragraph 3 of the present Article 3. In this case, the intended Telecommunications Services specified in the Registration Declaration are deemed to fall under the General Authorization following the lapse of a four (4) week period, without prejudice to paragraphs 7 & 8 of this article.
- 6. EETT shall require further information from the applicant as is described in paragraph 5 above, only if the applicant intends to provide a telecommunications activity which does not belong in any specified category from Annex A to this Regulation or is a novel telecommunications activity or is questioned whether it is subject to a General Authorization or an Individual License or a Simple Resale of Telecommunications Services.
- 7. If EETT determines on a preliminary basis that the Registration Declaration will be rejected, it issues a statement to the applicant, where the reasons for the preliminary assessment are included either within the fifteen (15) day period according to paragraph 3 of the present article 3, or within the four (4) week period according to paragraph 5 of the same article, inviting the applicant to express its opinion within an appropriate



period. In this case, EETT issues a decision within six (6) weeks from the filing of the relevant Registration Declaration, in accordance with paragraph 4 of Article 5 of Law 2867/2000. In this decision:

- i. Either it confirms that the intended Telecommunications Services are subject to a General Authorization Regime and may commence immediately;
- ii. Or it allows the provision of the intended Telecommunications Services on the basis of temporary terms;
- iii. Or it rejects the Registration Declaration and the provision of the intended Telecommunications Service provisionally on the basis of stated reasons, which are communicated to the applicant.
- 8. If the provision of the Telecommunications Services is allowed on the basis of temporary terms or is provisionally rejected, EETT shall issue a decision setting either the final terms or giving the reasons for final rejection, within one (1) month from this decision.
- 9. EETT may reject a Registration Declaration for a General Authorization only if the specific Telecommunications Services require an Individual license under Article 6 of Law 2867/2000 or is not legal because of infringement of other provisions of Law 2867/2000, Presidential Decrees, Ministerial Decisions, Regulations or Decisions issued on the basis of Law 2867/2000 or of the general laws for telecommunications activities.

10. The Registration Declaration shall be amended:

- a. In case the applicant declares its intent to modify the specified telecommunications services by filing in a new Registration Declaration, according to Annex A to this Regulation that is subject to provisions of paragraphs 1 to 9 of this article. The Registration Declaration shall be accompanied by the information provided in Annex A to this Regulation, where a sample of the form for the Registration Declaration is included as well.
- b. In case the applicant declares its intent to interrupt the provision of some of the specified telecommunications services by filing in a new Registration Declaration, pursuant to Annex A to this Regulation. The Registration Declaration shall be accompanied by the information provided in Annex A of this regulation, where a sample of the form of the Registration Declaration is included as well.



c. In case the applicant declares its intent to modify the administrative information supplied by the telecommunications company, according to Annex A. Any information modification shall be communicated within seven (7) days from its occurrence.

Article 4

Terms and Conditions of General Authorizations

- 1. EETT may attach terms and conditions about General Authorizations to the list in Annex A during the introduction of new telecommunications services or afterwards, requesting Telecommunications Service providers to:
 - a. Comply with certain conditions regarding the protection of users or subscribers in relation particularly to the prior approval of the standard subscriber contract by EETT, the provision of detailed and accurate information, especially on the quality of provided services and the provision of a procedure for dispute settlement, publication and adequate notice of any change in access conditions, including tariffs, quality and availability of services;
 - b. Make contributions to a universal service fund in accordance with current law:
 - c. Provide customer information necessary for the provision of directory services;
 - d. Provide specific emergency services;
 - e. Make special arrangements for disabled people;
 - f. Comply with specific conditions relating to networks interconnection and service interoperability, in accordance with Article 8 of Law 2867/2000 and obligations under current European Community law;
 - g. Comply with specific conditions, which may be imposed on providers with significant market power.
- 2. Unless the procedure specified in Paragraphs 7 & 8 of Article 3 above applies, EETT shall give at least one (1) month advance notice of its intent to issue terms and conditions for new or current telecommunications activities under a General Authorizations Regime, via announcements in two (2) daily political and in two (2) daily economical newspapers of pan-Hellenic circulation as well as on its website, inviting affected and



interested parties to express their views on the proposed measures. The terms are enacted within one month from the completion of the consultation.

- 3. Terms and conditions attached to General Authorizations shall be published on the website of EETT.
- 4. Terms and conditions for the provision of specific telecommunication activities under a General Authorization Regime may be amended by EETT in objectively justified cases and in a proportionate manner. Forty five (45) days before the relevant decision, EETT shall give notice of its intent to amend terms and conditions to General Authorizations in two (2) political and two (2) financial daily newspapers of pan-hellenic circulation as well as on its website, inviting interested parties to express their views on the proposed measures.

Article 5

Telecommunications Services Registry

- 1. EETT establishes the Telecommunications Services Registry which consists of records from Registration Declarations, in printed and electronic form. A Registration Declaration inserted in the Telecommunications Services Registry functions as a General Authorization, under the conditions of the present Regulation.
- 2. The Telecommunications Services Registry shall include the following information:
 - a. Name and address of the provider.
 - b. Legal form of the provider, authorized attorney and legal representative of the provider in Greece.
 - c. Transmission lines and infrastructure use.
 - d. Specification of services.
 - e. Reference Number and date of Registration Declaration.
 - f. Modifications that may occur to the General Authorization of the Telecommunications Service Provider.



Article 6

Compliance

- 1. Telecommunications Service providers must not exceed or infringe the content of the General Authorizations or terms and conditions attached thereto or other general obligations, which are included in Law 2867/2000, in Presidential Decrees, Regulations or Decisions issued on the basis of Law 2867/2000.
- 2. In case that a Telecommunications Service provider under a General Authorization Regime does not comply with a term included in the General Authorization, EETT may inform it that it is prohibited to provide specific Telecommunications Services, or/and impose administrative penalties according to current legislature, by way of a reasoned decision. Before imposing such measures, EETT provides an opportunity to the interested Telecommunications Service provider to comply with the terms of the General Authorization within one (1) month from the date of the notification of its decision. At the same time, it gives a chance to the interested provider to express their opinion concerning the application of the above term of the General Authorization. If the telecommunications service provider complies with the terms, EETT issues a justified decision within two (2) months from its initial decision, and proceeds to the rejection or amendment of its decision. In case that the Telecommunications service provider does not comply with the terms, EETT finalizes its justified Decision, within two (2) months from its initial interference, and notifies the interested provider of it within one week from its issue.

Article 7

Termination of Telecommunications activities

1. The Telecommunication Service provider shall notify EETT of the termination of the telecommunications activities, under a General Authorizations Regime, one (1) month before the termination date. In the notification, which shall be made on the form included in the Annex to this Regulation, reference shall be made to the registration number in the



Telecommunications Services Registry. Any fee obligation is met until the date EETT is notified of the termination.

2. In case of termination of the Telecommunications Service Provider, which submitted the Registration Declaration because it merged with another legal entity, the second legal entity is obliged to notify EETT of the termination of provisions of telecommunications activities by the first entity, according to paragraph 1 above. The second legal entity is also obliged to proceed to an amendment of its Registration Declaration in order to provide the additional services that the first legal entity provided or to proceed to a Registration Declaration if it did not provide any telecommunications services until the date of the merger.

Article 8

Validity Period of General Authorization

- 1. General Authorizations are valid for an indefinite period of time, unless the Registration Declaration filed by the Telecommunications Service provider contains a time limitation, or EETT imposes a limitation. EETT may impose a limitation only in exceptional cases via a justified decision, after an audition of the applicant.
- 2. Telecommunication activities under General Authorizations is void if:
 - i. A provider of telecommunications services files a notification pursuant to article 7 above that telecommunication activities under a General Authorization is no longer provided, or if
 - ii. The time set for the service provision has expired, or if
 - iii. The provision of Telecommunications Services is prohibited in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 2 of the present Regulation.



Article 9

Fees

All telecommunications undertakings, which operate under a General Authorization are required to pay to EETT an administrative fee of 300 Euros for the first service category and 50 Euros for each additional service category for which a Registration Declaration or an amendment is submitted. This fee is paid each time a Registration Declaration or an amendment is submitted to EETT.

Article 10

Administrative Penalties

In case of a violation of current legislature or terms of the present Regulation, or conditions that arise from telecommunications laws under a General Authorization, EETT may impose administrative penalties pursuant to Article 12 of Law 2867/2000, by way of a reasoned decision and after an audition of the interested party.

Article 11

Transitional Provision

- Undertakings which already perform telecommunications activities under a General Authorization Regime continue to perform those activities according to the present Regulation. Fees are imposed only for each new added category of telecommunications services.
- 2. Registration Declarations, which had been submitted before the present Regulation is set in force, are governed by the provisions of the present Regulation.



Article 12

Commencement Validity

The present Regulation enters into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
